Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- *Dressing and undressing independently.
- *Taking turns and sharing.
- *Good relationships with peers and adults.
- *Expressing feelings and communicates freely with a range of people.
- *Shows involvement in chosen tasks.

Literacy.

- *Listens and responds appropriately.
- *Uses language to recreate roles.
- *Shows an awareness of rhyme & alliteration
- *Links some sounds to letters.
- *Is developing an interest in books.
- *Experiments with mark making.

Maths.

- *Counts reliably up to 10 objects.
- *Says number names in order.
- *Finds one more or less from a group of 10.
- *Sorts and matches objects and talks about sorting them.
- *Describes shape.

Understanding the world.

- *Shows curiosity and interest by exploring surroundings.
- *Asks questions about why things happen.
- *Observes similarities and differences.
- *Constructs in a purposeful way.

Physical development.

- *Shows an awareness of space.
- *Has appropriate control over small and large scale movements.
- *Demonstrates fine motor control and coordination.

Expressive Art and Design

- *Engages in representational play.
- *Engages in music making.
- *Tries to capture experiences using varied media e.g. painting, collage, play.
- *Sings simple songs from memory.
