Overview




-All around us, there are some things that are alive, some things that are dead, and some things that have never been alive.

-A <u>habitat</u> is a <u>home environment</u> for plants, animals, and other living thing
-Examples of habitats include:
-Desert; Rainforest;
-Woodland; Ocean;
-Meadow; Seashore.
- <u>Micro-habitats</u> are <u>small, specific hor</u>
<u>environments</u> , e.g. individual trees, a pond, under a rock, or a pile of logs.
-Habitats contain features that make them <u>suitable</u> to the things that live
there, e.g., food, shelter, or temperatu
- <u>Habitats can change</u> over the year & over time, so some animals <u>migrate.</u>
